## Making Room for the Big Toys

### 330-tonne crane makes appearance in late August

The Bioenergy construction site saw less than normal activity for the majority of August while preparation began for a busy September. But things turned around quickly on the last week of August when new trailers, new contractors, and a scenic 330-tonne crane were all added onto the site. RFP-016 Thermal Oil Plant Structural and Mechanical Installation Services was awarded to Robwel Constructors LP out of Meadow Lake (owned 100% by Clearwater River Dene Nation Group of Companies) and requires the use of a large crane provided by Sterling Crane out of Saskatoon. The crane is expected to be in use until the end of 2020 as construction continues on the 120' Thermal Oil Plant.

The construction site uses the services of FD Security to do the following:

- 24/7 monitoring of Bioenergy Construction Site
- Ensure visitors check in/check out when entering/exiting the site
- Monitor visitors for any symptoms of Covid-19
- Control the flow of traffic in and out of the site
- Report any suspicious activity to site Safety Manager
