**Mandatory Masks Required as of October 20<sup>th</sup>**

For the health and safety of our employees, our contractors, and visitors to the MLTC Bioenergy Centre, we have implemented a mandatory mask policy effective October 20, 2020. This rule applies to all individuals when inside an office building or construction site trailer with the exception of when you are working at your own station. Signs have been posted on the doors of all buildings and complimentary masks are available if needed.

This decision was made following the rise in positive cases of COVID-19 throughout the province, as well as in the Meadow Lake region. Here are a few things you can do to help stop the spread of COVID-19:
